## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT relating to compensation of County Commissioners of Hancock County.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Sect. 1. On and after January 1, in the year of our Lord
- 2 one thousand nine hundred and three, the pay of each county
- 3 commissioner of the county of Hancock shall be three dollars
- 4 and fifty cents for each day actually employed in the service
- 5 of the county, including the time spent in traveling and each
- 6 commissioner shall have ten cents a mile for the distance
- 7 actually travelled.
- Sect. 2. All Acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this 2 act are hereby repealed.
  - Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
