STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT to prohibit the taking of clams in the shores or flats within the town of Scarboro.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. No person shall take or dig or destroy in any
- 2 manner clams in any of the shores or flats within the town of
- 3 Scarboro from the first day of April until the first day of Octo-
- 4 ber in each year under a penalty of not less than ten or more
- 5 than one hundred dollars for each and every violation of this
- 6 statute.
 - Sect. 2. The aforesaid section shall not apply to inhabi-
- 2 tants or residents of said town taking clams for the con-
- 3 sumption of himself and family nor to hotel keepers within
- 4 the town taking clams for the use of their hotels.
 - Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
