## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT relating to bonds given by collectors of taxes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The bond given by any collector of taxes to the

- 2 inhabitants of the town or plantation of which he is collector,
- 3 shall, after its approval and acceptance by the municipal
- 4 officers of such town or plantation, be recorded by the town
- 5 or plantation clerk, in the town or plantation records, and
- 6 such record shall be prima facie evidence of the contents of
- 7 such bond, but a failure to so record shall be no defence in
- 8 any action upon such bond.
- Sect. 2. This act shall take effect on the first day of June, 2 nineteen hundred and three.
