STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT to abolish the office of inspector of factories, workshops, mines and quarries.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

The office of inspector of factories, workshops, mines and 2 quarries is hereby abolished and all of the duties, rights and 3 authority pertaining to said office are hereby devolved upon 4 and given to the commissioner of industrial and labor 5 statistics.
