STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT to amend chapter 51 of the Revised Statutes, relating
to the duties of railroad commissioners.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Section 114 of chapter 51 of the Revised Stat-
utes is hereby amended by striking out the words "shall give
a certificate thereof to the clerk of the corporation, therein
stating the condition of the road and rolling stock," from the
fifth, sixth and seventh lines and inserting after the word
"doings" in the eighth line the words 'therein stating the
condition of the road and rolling stock,' so that said section
as amended shall read as follows:

‘Section 114. A majority of the board, annually, between
10 the first of April and October, and at any other time on appli-
11 cation or whenever they think necessary, shall carefully
12 examine the tracks, rolling stock, bridges, viaducts and cul-
13 verts of all railroads; and shall annually in December make
14 a report to the governor of their official doings, therein stat-
15 ing the condition of the road and rolling stock, with such
16 facts as they deem of public interest or which he may require ;
17 and all persons managing railroads shall give the board such
18 information as they at any time request.’

Sect. 2. Section 115 of chapter 51 of the Revised Statutes
2 is hereby repealed.
