IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND THREE.

---

AN ACT to prohibit all ice fishing in Lake Webb or Weld pond,  
so called, in the town of Weld, county of Franklin.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows :*

Section 1. It shall be unlawful to fish for, take, catch or  
2 kill any kind of fish in Lake Webb or Weld pond, so called,  
3 in the town of Weld, Franklin county, between October first  
4 and May first of the following year.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates any of the provisions of this act  
2 shall be punished by a fine of not less than ten nor more than  
3 thirty dollars and costs for each offense and a further fine of  
4 one dollar for each fish caught, taken or killed in violation  
5 of this law.
