
STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT to prohibit the dumping of herring and all fish offal in the waters of Jonesport and Addison.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. The dumping of herring and all fish offal is
- 2 hereby prohibited in the waters adjacent to the towns of
- 3 Jonesport and Addison, in the county of Washington, under
- 4 a penalty of not less than ten nor more than fifty dollars for
- 5 each offense.
 - Sect. 2. All fines or penalties imposed under this act may
- 2 be recovered by indictment or action of debt, one-fourth of
- 3 the penalty to party prosecuting and three-fourths to town
- 4 school fund in the town where the offense may be committed.
 - Sect. 3. This act to take effect August first, 1903.
