IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT to prohibit the dumping of herring and all fish offal  
in the waters of Jonesport and Addison.

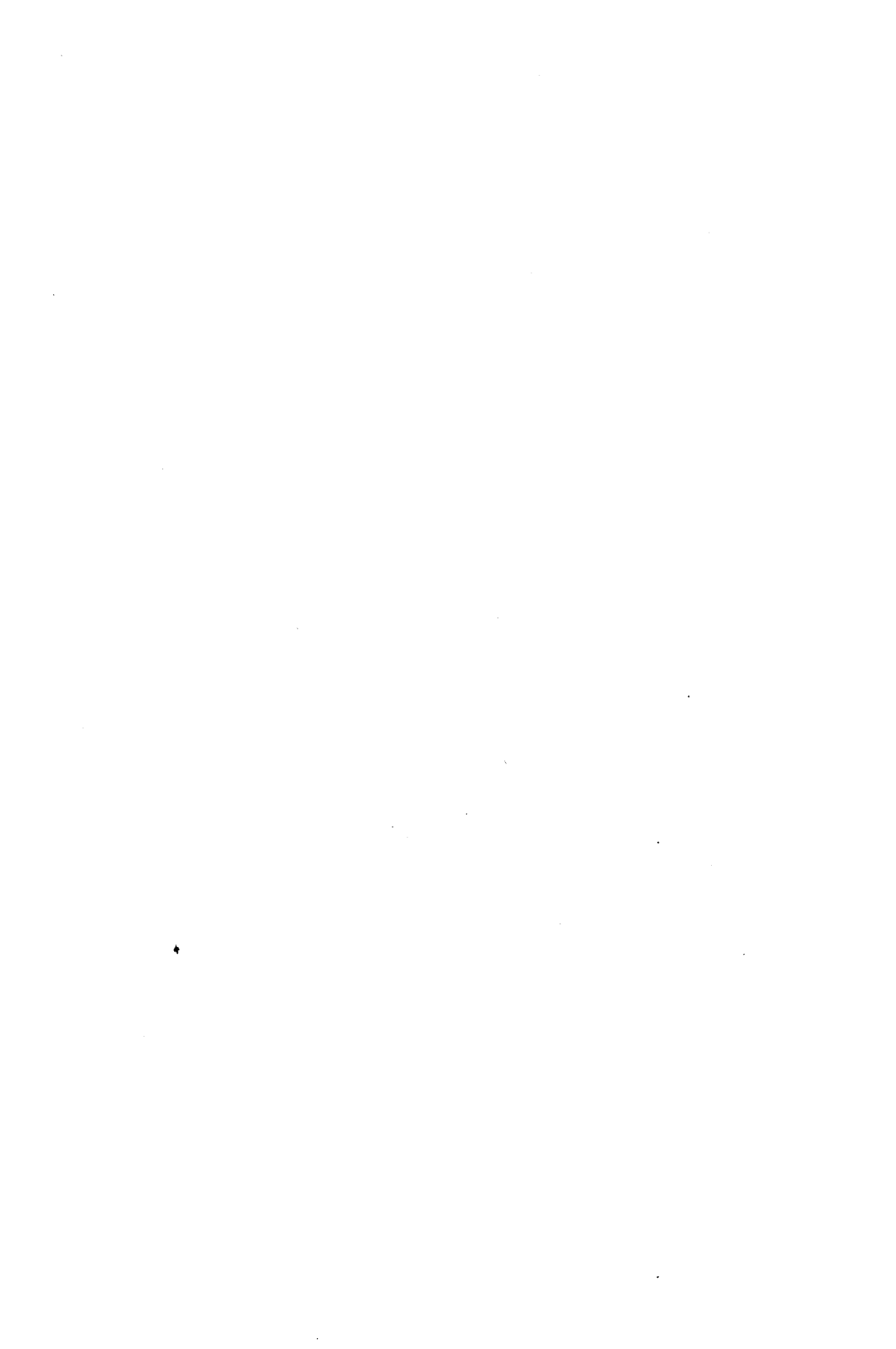

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The dumping of herring and all fish offal is  
2 hereby prohibited in the waters adjacent to the towns of  
3 Jonesport and Addison, in the county of Washington, under  
4 a penalty of not less than ten nor more than fifty dollars for  
5 each offense.

Sect. 2. All fines or penalties imposed under this act may  
2 be recovered by indictment or action of debt, one-fourth of  
3 the penalty to party prosecuting and three-fourths to town  
4 school fund in the town where the offense may be committed.

Sect. 3. This act to take effect August first, 1903.
