STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT to legalize the acts and doings of Nashville Plantation,
Aroostook County.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. All acts and doings of Nashville plantation,
2 Aroostook county, Maine, prior to this date, are hereby legal-
3 ized and made valid.

Sect. 2. Said plantation may raise money at any annual
2 meeting for the breaking, opening and repairing of snow
3 roads, and to keep its winter roads passable for public travel,
4 to be expended by the assessors of said plantation.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
