STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT relating to the open season for fishing in "Wilson
lake," in the town of Wilton.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The open season for fishing in "Wilson lake,"
2 in the town of Wilton, shall begin as soon as the lake is free
3 from ice, instead of May 1st, in each year, as is now provided
4 by law.

Sect. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent herewith
2 are hereby repealed.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
