STATE OF MAINE,

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT to authorize the town of York to construct and main-
tain sewers in said town.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The town of York is hereby authorized to con-
2 struct and maintain a system or systems of sewers within said
3 town in such places and such manner as may be determined
4 by the inhabitants of said town at any legal town meeting,
5 and to make appropriations necessary therefor.

Sect. 2. Said town is authorized, for the purposes afore-
2 said, to construct, lay down and maintain all such pipes or
3 other structures as may be necessary for properly conducting,
4 discharging and disposing of sewerage; and to excavate in

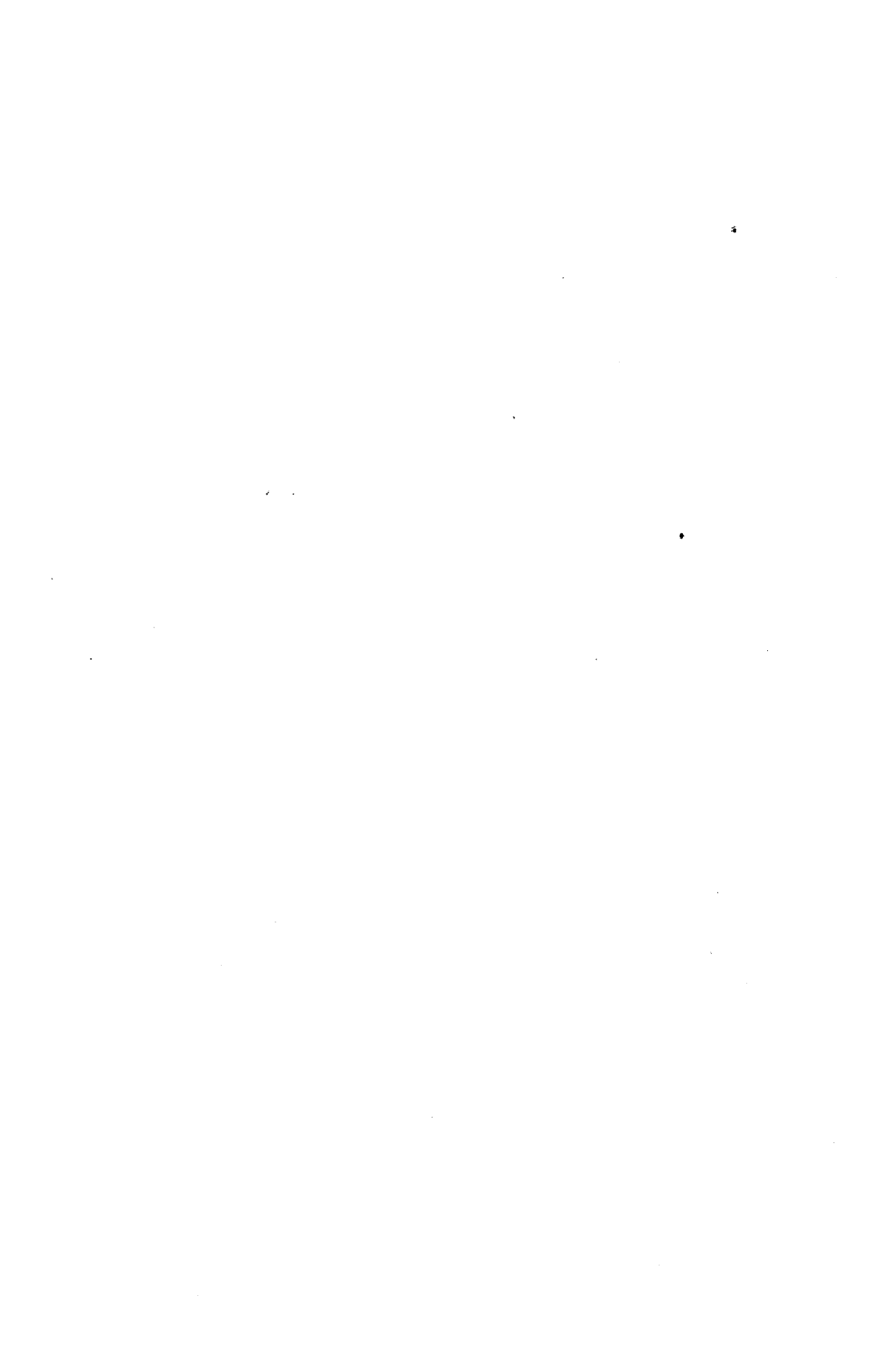
5 and through any land in said town when necessary for the
6 purpose aforesaid.

Sect. 3. Said town is authorized to lay, extend and main-
2 tain its pipes into, under and across tidal waters, and to build
3 and maintain all structures necessary therefor, but in such
4 manner as not to obstruct navigation.

Sect. 4. Said town is authorized to lay, construct and
2 maintain in, through, under and along any railroads and
3 water courses in said town all pipes and other structures nec-
4 essary or convenient for the purposes herein set forth, and to
5 table up, replace and repair the same when necessary. Pro-
6 vided, that in case of crossing any railroad at any point out-
7 side the limits of any highway, unless said town of York shall
8 agree with the corporation, person or persons owning and
9 operating such railroad, as to place, manner and conditions
10 of such crossings, the Railroad Commissioners shall deter-
11 mine the place, manner and conditions thereof; and all work
12 within the limits of the location of such railroad shall be done
13 under the supervision and to the satisfaction of the officials of
14 such railroad, but at the expense of said town.

Sect. 5. To carry out the purposes aforesaid said town of
2 York is hereby granted all the rights, powers and privileges
3 which towns, and their municipal officers, have under the first
4 sixteen sections of chapter sixteen of the Revised Statutes, as
5 amended, and under chapter two hundred and eighty-five of
6 the Public Laws of 1889, relating to drains and sewers.

Sect. 6. This act shall take effect when approved.
