
IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT relating to the powers and duties of administrators de bonis non.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

An administrator de bonis non shall have the power and it 2 shall be his duty, to collect and receive from his predecessor 3 or his heirs, executors or administrators and from all other 4 sources, all the property and assets of the estate of the 5 deceased, including the proceeds from the sale of real estate, 6 not already distributed, and shall account for and distribute 7 the same as though he were the original administrator or 8 executor; and all sums recovered on any probate bond shall 9 be a part of the estate, but so much thereof as is recovered on 10 any real estate bond shall be distributed as is provided for the 11 distribution of the proceeds of the sale of real estate.
