STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT to provide for the assessment and expenditure of the income arising from the permanent school fund in certain towns.

Be it enacted by the Scnate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section I. All towns incorporated since 1788, not formerly 2 parts of other towns, which fail to account for the permanent 3 school fund arising from sale or lease of school lands in said 4 towns, shall annually raise and expend for the maintenance 5 of common schools not less than forty-five (\$45) dollars in 6 addition to the amount required by law to be raised and 7 expended for the support of said schools.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect January first, 1904.
