IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT to enlarge the corporate powers of Lawrence Lumber Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Lawrence Lumber Company, a corporation

- 2 organized under the general laws of this State, and located
- 3 in Jonesboro in the county of Washington, is hereby author-
- 4 ized and empowered to construct and maintain on and in
- 5 Chandler's river and its tributaries, after it shall first have
- 6 acquired by purchase or otherwise the right so to do, dams,
- 7 side dams, shear-waters, bulkheads, piers, booms and camps,
- 8 to remove rock and other material, and to make any other

9 improvements which it can legally do for the purpose of 10 facilitating the driving of logs of said corporation, and of 11 those under their control, on said Chandler's river and its 12 tributaries.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
