STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT to repeal an act of the Public Laws of the year 1903 entitled "An Act to amend section 12 of chapter three of the Revised Statutes as amended by chapter three hundred and thirty-five of the Public Laws of 1885 and to repeal conflicting statutes relating to the electing of collectors of taxes" (and approved by the governor March 4th.)

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. An act approved March 4, 1903, and reading 2 as follows:

'Sect. I. Section twelve of chapter three of the Revised 4 Statutes as amended by chapter three hundred and thirty-five 5 of the Public Laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-five is 6 hereby amended by adding thereto the following words:

7 nor shall a collector be eligible to or hold the office of treas-8 urer until he has completed his duties under his warrant and9 had a final settlement with the town.

Sect. 2. Section one hundred and seventy-six of chapter 11 six of the Revised Statutes and all other acts and parts of 12 acts inconsistent with the preceding section are hereby 13 repealed.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.'

Is hereby repealed.

Sect. 2. All acts and parts of acts expressly or impliedly 2 repealed by the passage of the act herein repealed are hereby 3 revived and re-enacted and all acts done in accordance with 4 the laws herein enacted are hereby made legal and valid.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
