STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT to extend the powers of the Union River Light, Gas & Power Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section I. The Union River Light, Gas & Power Company 2 is hereby authorized to purchase, hold, own and enjoy the

- 3 franchises, property, shares of stock, rights, easements, privi-
- 4 leges and immunities of the Ellsworth Water Company, and
- 5 the said Ellsworth Water Company is hereby authorized to
- 6 sell, transfer and convev its franchises, property, shares of
- 7 stock, rights, easements, privileges and immunities to the said
- 8 Union River Light, Gas & Power Company upon such terms
- 9 as said companies may determine between themselves, and
- 10 upon such purchase and sale and transfer, the said Union
- 11 River Light, Gas & Power Company shall succeed to and
- 12 have, hold and enjoy all the rights, franchises, easements,

13 privileges and immunities heretofore and hereafter acquired 14 by or granted to said Ellsworth Water Company and have all 15 the powers and privileges and be subject to all the duties, 16 restrictions and liabilities by law incident to such corporations.

Sect. 2. The Union River Light, Gas & Power Company is 2 hereby authorized to purchase, hold, own and enjoy the fran-3 chises, property, shares of stock, rights, easements, privileges 4 and immunities of the Bar Harbor Electric Light Company 5 and the said Bar Harbor Electric Light Company is hereby 6 authorized to sell, transfer and convey its franchises, property, 7 shares of stock, rights, easements, privileges and immunities 8 to the said Union River Light, Gas & Power Company upon 9 such terms as these said companies may determine between 10 themselves, and upon such purchase and sale and transfer, II the said Union River Light, Gas & Power Company shall 12 succeed to and have, hold and enjoy all the rights, franchises, 13 easements, privileges and immunities heretofore and here-14 after acquired by or granted to said Bar Harbor Electric 15 Light Company, and have all the powers and privileges and 16 be subject to all the duties, restrictions and liabilities by law 17 incident to such corporations.

Sect. 3 In addition to its other purposes as set forth in its 2 certificate of organization, approved by the attorney general 3 of the State of Maine, October 6, A. D. 1902, said Union 4 River Light, Gas & Power Company is hereby authorized and 5 empowered to make, generate, sell, lease, conduct, distribute 6 and supply gas or any by-products thereof, electricity, or 7 electrically transmitted energy or power, for any or all pur-8 poses, anywhere within the limits of any or all towns, town-9 ships, plantations and cities, in the county of Hancock, said 10 State of Maine, provided, however, that none of the rights 11 or privileges granted said Union River Light, Gas & Power 12 Company under this section shall be exercised within the 13 limits of the city of Ellsworth, Hancock county, Maine,

14 unless and until said Union River Light, Gas & Power Com-15 pany shall first purchase a majority of the outstanding capital 16 stock of said Ellsworth Water Company and such of the 17 minority stock as is hereinafter provided and provided also 18 that none of the rights or privileges granted said Union River 19 Light, Gas & Power Company under this section shall be 20 exercised within the limits of the towns of Eden, Mount 21 Desert or Tremont, unless and until, said Union River Light, 22 Gas & Power Company shall purchase a majority of the out-23 standing capital stock of said Bar Harbor Electric Light 24 Company and such of the minority stock as is hereinafter 25 provided and provided also that no electricity or electrically 26 transmitted energy or power shall be so sold, leased, dis-27 tributed or supplied by said Union River Light, Gas & Power 28 Company within the limits of the town of Castine, in said 29 Hancock county, for electric lighting purposes, unless and 30 until said Union River Light, Gas & Power Company shall 31 purchase a majority of the outstanding capital stock of said 32 Castine Water Company and such of the minority stock as is 33 hereinafter provided. Any stockholder in the Ellsworth 34 Water Company, the Bar Harbor Electric Light Company 35 or the Castine Water Company may within thirty days after 36 the approval of this act file a written notice with the clerk of 37 the corporation of which he is a member expressing his 38 willingness to sell his stock in such corporation to the Union 39 River Light, Gas & Power Company at a price to be agreed 40 upon or if not agreed upon to be fixed by any justice of the 41 supreme judicial court after petition therefor by said Union 42 River Light, Gas & Power Company and notice and hearing 43 and the said Union River Light, Gas & Power Company shall 44 purchase such stock from such stockholder, or the subsequent 45 holder thereof, in each case before the exercise of the rights 46 in this section granted in the town or towns where such corpo47 ration is authorized to do business under its franchises as 48 respectively stated in the provisos of this section.

In exercising the rights or privileges granted under this 50 section, the said Union River Light, Gas & Power Company 51 shall have all the powers and privileges, and be subject to all 52 the duties, restrictions and liabilities by law incident to such 53 corporations.

- Sect. 4. In addition to its other purposes as set forth in
- 2 its certificate of organization and the rights herein above
- 3 granted said Union River Light, Gas & Power Com-
- 4 pany is hereby authorized to make, generate, sell, lease, con-
- 5 duct, distribute and supply gas or any by-products thereof,
- 6 electricity or electrically transmitted energy of power any-
- 7 where within the limits of the towns of Orrington, Eddington,
- 8 Holden, Clifton and the City of Brewer, in Penobscot County,
- 9 State of Maine, so far as reasonably necessary and convenient
- 10 to enable said Union River Light, Gas & Power Company to
- 11 supply same to the Eastern Manufacturing Company, its suc-
- 12 cessors and assigns, owners or tenants of the real estate and
- 13 plant or any part thereof situated in said City of Brewer and
- 14 now occupied by said Eastern Manufacturing Company.

In exercising the rights or privileges granted under this sec-16 tion, the said Union River Light, Gas & Power Company shall

- 17 have all the powers and privileges, and be subject to all the
- 18 duties, restrictions and liabilities by law incident to such cor-
- 19 porations.

Sect. 5. This act shall take effect when approved.
