STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT to prohibit the throwing of sawdust and other refuse into Norton, Brown or Heath brooks or their tributaries in the towns of Shapleigh and Limerick.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section I. No person shall cast or throw into Norton brook 2 in the town of Shapleigh or into Brown or Heath brooks in 3 the town of Limerick in the county of York or into any of 4 the tributaries of said brooks, any sawdust, shavings, bark or 5 other mill waste, or place or deposit such mill waste or other 6 refuse along the banks in such manner that the same shall fall 7 or be washed into said brooks or their tributaries.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates any of the provisions of this act 2 shall be subject to a penalty of not less than five dollars nor 3 more than fifty dollars for each offense.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
