STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE laying a tax on counties of the State for the years
nineteen hundred and three and nineteen hundred and four.

Resolved, That the sum annexed to the counties in the following schedule is hereby granted as a tax on each county respectively to be appropriated, assessed, collected and applied to the purposes of paying the debts and necessary expenses of the same and for other purposes ordered by law:

For the year one thousand nine hundred and three:

Androscoggin, thirty-five thousand dollars; Aroostook, forty-five thousand dollars; Cumberland, ninety-four thousand five hundred and fifty dollars; Franklin, ten thousand dollars; Hancock, nineteen thousand eight hundred and fifty dollars; Kennebec, thirty-seven thousand seven hundred and fifty-two dollars and thirty-three cents; Knox, fifteen thou-

13 sand dollars; Lincoln, nine thousand eight hundred and
14 seventy-five dollars; Oxford, twenty-five thousand dollars;
15 Penobscot, forty-five thousand dollars; Piscataquis, twenty-
