STATE OF MAINE,

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT to amend chapter 372 of the Public Laws of 1885, relating to the compensation of the county commissioners for Oxford county.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Chapter three hundred and seventy-two of the

- 2 Public Laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-five is amended
- 3 by striking out the words "two dollars and fifty cents" in the
- 4 second line of said chapter, and inserting instead thereof, the
- 5 words 'three dollars,' so that said chapter, as amended, shall
- 6 read as follows:

'Each county commissioner for Oxford county shall receive 8 three dollars per day while actually employed in the service 9 of the county, including the time spent in traveling, for which 10 he shall have eight cents a mile for the distance actually 11 traveled; but he shall not have more than one travel in the 12 same hearing or session, nor for more than two adjournments 13 of any regular term, nor for service or travel on more than 14 one petition or case at the same time, nor anything for travel 15 or attendance at the legislature connected with the annual 16 county estimates, nor for any additional trouble or expense 17 of any kind.'
