STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT to set off the town of Isle au Haut and all islands within the limits of said town from the county of Hancock and annex said town to the county of Knox.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The town of Isle au Haut in the county of
2 Hancock with all the islands within the limits of said town
3 together with the inhabitants thereof be and they hereby are
4 set off from the said county of Hancock and annexed to the
5 county of Knox and the said inhabitants shall enjoy the same
6 rights and be subject to the same requisitions as the inhab-
7 itants of the county of Knox.

Sect. 2. Said inhabitants, so annexed, with the estates so
2 set off shall be holden to pay the arrears of all taxes which
3 have been legally assessed upon them, together with their

4 proportion of the net corporate indebtedness of said county
5 of Hancock at the time this act may take effect, said propor-
6 portion to be ascertained by the last State valuation and the
7 same to be assessed and collected by the proper officers of
8 said town of Isle au Haut as county taxes are now assessed.

Sect. 3. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this
2 act are hereby repealed.

Sect. 4. This act shall take effect when approved.
