STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT relating to the election of a road commissioner in the town of Boothbay Harbor.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The town of Boothbay Harbor is authorized at

- 2 its next annual meeting, and thereafterwards, to fix the
- 3 tenure of office of the road commissioner by it elected at not
- 4 less than one nor more than five years. When the town fails
- 5 to elect such officer and the selectmen have the power of
- 6 appointment, as provided by general law, such appointment
- 7 may be made for a term not exceeding five years as they may
- 8 determine.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
