
STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT to ratify the lease of the Fish River Railroad and to authorize the sale of said railroad to the Bangor and Aroostook Railroad Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. The lease of the Fish River Railroad to the
- 2 Bangor and Aroostook Railroad Company by the Fish River
- 3 Railroad Company is hereby made valid, ratified and con-
- 4 firmed.
 - Sect. 2. The Fish River Railroad Company is hereby
- 2 authorized to sell and convey its railroad and the franchise
- 3 thereof and all its other property to the Bangor and Aroos-
- 4 took Railroad Company, and the Bangor and Aroostook
- 5 Railroad Company is hereby authorized to purchase the same. Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
