IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND THREE.

---

AN ACT to authorize the town of Boothbay Harbor to construct  
a bridge across the harbor in said town.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The town of Boothbay Harbor is hereby author-  
2 ized to lay out, construct and maintain, across the harbor in  
3 said town, a suitable highway bridge alongside the present  
4 foot bridge, running parallel with said foot bridge and  
5 adjoining the same. Said highway bridge shall not exceed  
6 twenty feet in width and shall be provided with a draw of  
7 the same opening as the draw of the present foot bridge.  
8 Authority is hereby granted for the erection of all such piers  
9 as may be necessary therefor.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
