## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT to authorize the town of Boothbay Harbor to construct a bridge across the harbor in said town.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section I. The town of Boothbay Harbor is hereby author-

- 2 ized to lay out, construct and maintain, across the harbor in
- 3 said town, a suitable highway bridge alongside the present
- 4 foot bridge, running parallel with said foot bridge and
- 5 adjoining the same. Said highway bridge shall not exceed
- 6 twenty feet in width and shall be provided with a draw of
- 7 the same opening as the draw of the present foot bridge.
- 8 Authority is hereby granted for the erection of all such piers
- 9 as may be necessary therefor.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
