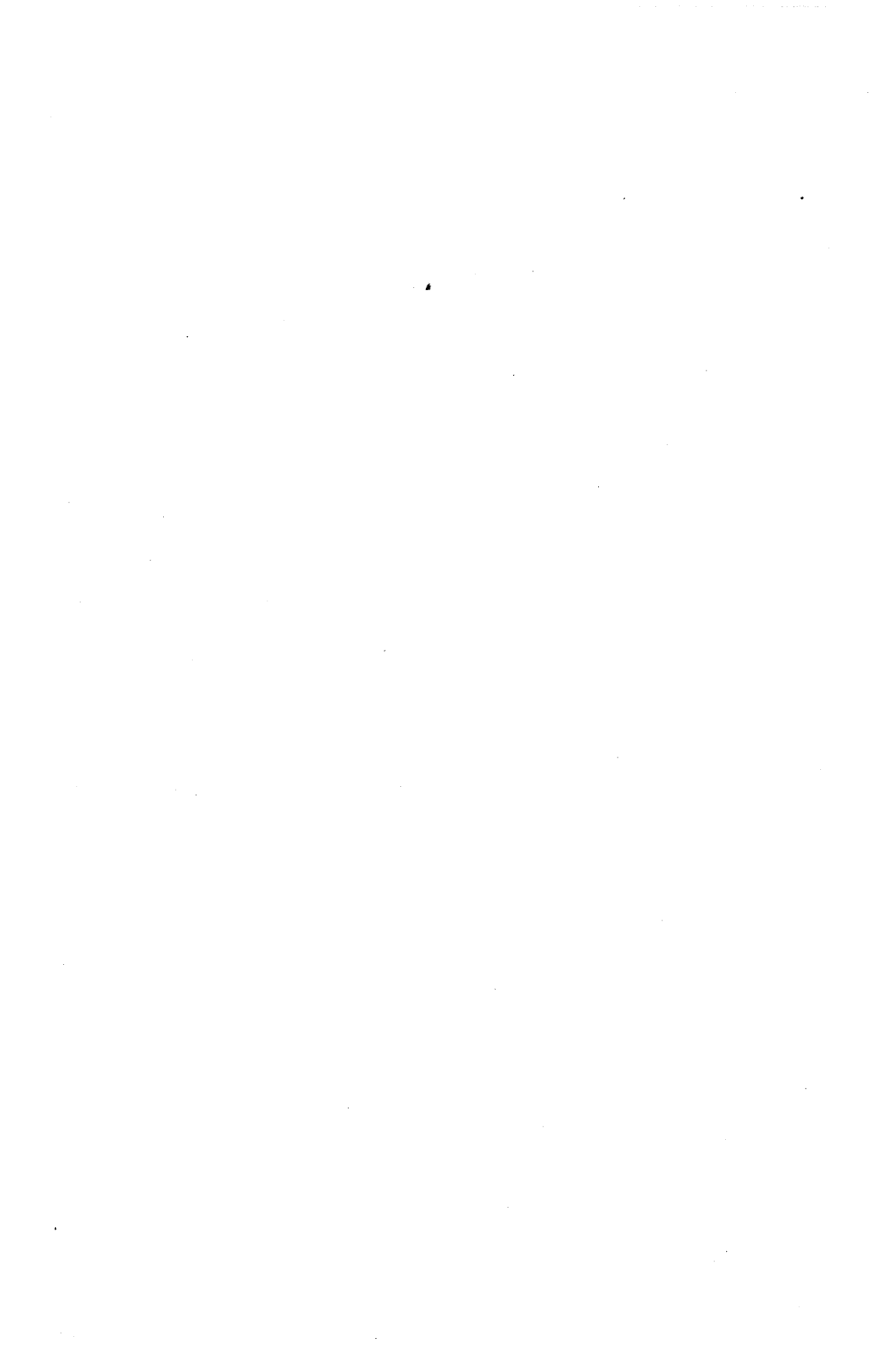
IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE

AN ACT to legalize the acts of St. Francis plantation in the
county of Aroostook.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. That the acts and doings of the plantation of
2 St. Francis in Aroostook county be made legal and the said
3 St. Francis plantation be and become a legal corporation.

Sect. 2. This act to take effect when approved.
