STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT to authorize the State Land Agent to convey to the Fish River Railroad Company, rights of way over public lots owned by the state.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The state land agent is hereby authorized, 2 empowered and directed, when thereto requested by the 3 Fish River Railroad Company to execute to said railroad 4 company, for a nominal consideration on behalf of the 5 state, a deed of right of way, six rods wide, over such 6 public lots owned by the state as are crossed by the rail-7 road of said company; the center line of said six rods to

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.

8 be the center line of the location of said railroad.
