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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND THREE.

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AN ACT to amend chapter one hundred forty-five of the Private  
and Special Laws of 1895, entitled "An Act to incorporate the  
Winn Water and Power Company."

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Section ten of chapter one hundred forty-five  
2 of the Private and Special Laws of 1895 is hereby amended  
3 by striking out in the second line of said section the word  
4 "one," and inserting in place thereof the word 'two,' so that  
5 said section as amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 10. The capital stock of said company shall not  
7 exceed two hundred thousand dollars, divided into shares of  
8 fifty dollars each. Said company may hold real and personal

9 estate necessary and convenient for its purposes aforesaid.'

Sect. 2. The rights, powers and privileges of said company  
2 are hereby extended, and the organization of said company  
3 as now existing is hereby confirmed.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
