RESOLVE for State Pensions.

Resolved, That the sum of eighty-five thousand dollars be
2 and is hereby appropriated to provide for State pensions for
3 invalid soldiers and sailors, their widows and orphans, and
4 the dependent children, parents and sisters of deceased
5 soldiers and sailors eligible thereto under existing law, for
6 the year nineteen hundred and three, and eighty-five thou-
7 sand dollars for the year nineteen hundred and four.
