STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT to incorporate the town of Castle Hill, in the county
of Aroostook.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Township number twelve, range four, west
2 from the east line of the State, in the county of Aroostook,
3 and known as Castle Hill plantation, is hereby incorporated
4 into a town by the name of Castle Hill, and the inhabitants
5 of said town are hereby vested with all the powers, privileges,
6 immunities and liabilities of other towns.

Sect. 2. The present board of assessors of Castle Hill plan-
2 tation are hereby authorized and required to call the first
3 meeting of the town under this act, for the choice of town

4 officers, by issuing their warrant for the same seven days
5 prior to the time of said meeting, which shall be holden in
6 the month of March of the present year.

Sect. 3. The town hereby created shall be possessed of all
2 the property and effects belonging to said plantation, and
3 shall assume all the liabilities thereof.

Sect. 4. This act shall take effect when approved.
