IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT to amend section 14 of chapter 51 of the Revised Statutes relating to the width of the location of railroads.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assemblea, as follows:

Section 1. Section 14, Chapter 51 of the Revised Statutes 2 is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

'Sect. 14. A railroad corporation for the location, construc-4 tion, repair and convenient use of its road may purchase or 5 take and hold as for public uses land and all materials in and 6 upon it; through woodland and forest the land so taken shall 7 not exceed six rods in width unless necessary for excavation, 8 embankment or materials, and through all land other than

- 9 woodland and forest the land so taken shall not exceed four 10 rods in width unless necessary for excavation, embankment
- 10 rods in width unless necessary for excavation, embankment

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
