STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT to amend chapter two hundred and eighty-five of the
Public Laws of nineteen hundred and one, entitled "An Act
providing for State roads and for the improvement thereof."

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section I. Section two of chapter two hundred and eighty-
2 five of the Public Laws of nineteen hundred and one is hereby
3 amended by striking out the word "one" in the fourth line of
4 said section and inserting in place thereof the word 'two';
5 also by striking out the word "August" in the eleventh line
6 of said section and inserting in place thereof the word 'Sep-
7 tember', so that said section, as amended, shall read as
8 follows:

‘Sect. 2. Towns establishing State roads as aforesaid may, 10 on complying with the conditions hereinafter set forth, receive 11 from the State one-half of the amount actually expended in 12 permanent improvement of said roads, not exceeding two 13 hundred dollars per year; provided that no town shall receive 14 such State aid unless its appropriation and expenditure for 15 such road shall amount to at least one hundred dollars and 16 shall have been exclusive of and in addition to the amount 17 regularly raised in such town for highways and bridges; and 18 provided also, that the amount so expended shall be used 19 before the first day of September in permanent improvement 20 of a continuous portion of said road, and in a manner satis- 21 factory to the county commissioners of the county wherein 22 said road is located. Such aid shall be paid from the State 23 treasury on and after the first day of January, upon certificate 24 by the governor and council as provided by section three.’

Sect. 2. Section six of said chapter is hereby amended by 2 striking out all of said section after the word “of” in the 3 second line thereof and inserting in place thereof the words 4 ‘forty thousand dollars shall be appropriated annually,’ so 5 that said section, as amended, shall read as follows:

‘Sect. 6. For the purpose of carrying out the provisions of 7 this act the sum of forty thousand dollars shall be appro- 8 priated annually.’

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
