### STATE OF MAINE.

#### RESOLVE in favor of Allegash Road.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the 2 sum of five hundred dollars to aid in repairing the Allegash 3 road, extending from Ashland to the Allegash river in Aroos-4 took county; provided, however, that said sum of five hun-5 dred dollars shall not be available unless there shall be pro-6 vided by subscription or otherwise a like sum of five hundred 7 dollars which shall be expended on said road in connection 8 with the amount hereby appropriated, under the direction 9 of an agent to be appointed for that purpose by the governor 10 and council.



#### STATEMENT OF FACTS.

That the road leading from the town of Ashland in Aroostook county to the Allegash river, known as the Allegash road, was laid out and bridged and repaired by the State in 1853; that said road is the main traveled way for supplies to all the lumbering operations on the waters tributary to the Aroostook and Allegash rivers and for all persons going to this region for game; that for a number of years said road has been made passable only by the voluntary contributions of persons using the same; that owing to the increase of travel, said road has become dangerous, and, at places, impassable; that said road is a public necessity.
