STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT to provide for the better protection of motor men and
conductors on electric cars.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. No electric cars shall be run on any road by
2 any corporation or company in this State between the first
3 day of November and the first day of April inclusive, in each
4 year, unless said cars are properly vestibuled, so as to protect
5 the motor men and conductors from exposure to the wind
6 and storms.

Sect. 2. Any corporation or persons violating the provi-
2 sions of this act shall be liable to a fine of not less than ten
3 nor more than twenty dollars for each offense, to be imposed
4 by any court of justice of competent jurisdiction upon com-
5 plaint or by indictment.

Sect. 3. All fines imposed under this act shall be paid to
2 the treasurer of the town or city in which the offense is
3 committed.

Sect. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force on and
2 after the first day of November, 1903.
