STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT additional and amendatory to chapter 376 of the
Private and Special Laws of 1889, as amended by chapter 479
of the Private and Special Laws of 1901, to enable the Maine
Lake Ice Company to increase its capital stock.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The Maine Lake Ice Company is hereby author-
2 ized and empowered to increase its capital stock to an amount
3 not exceeding one million dollars, and is further authorized
4 and empowered to issue its bonds, to pay, retire and cancel
5 its outstanding bonds and the mortgage securing the same,
6 and for the further construction and improvement of its
7 works and plant, and for other purposes of its incorporation,

8 and for such amount and upon such rate and time as it may
9 deem expedient, not to exceed the sum of one million dollars ;
10 and to secure such bonds by mortgage or deed of trust of all,
11 or any part of its franchise, property, rights and privileges
12 now owned or to be hereafter acquired.

Sect. 2. Said corporation may hold real and personal prop-
erty to an amount not exceeding one million dollars.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
