STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT to repeal section sixty-seven of chapter two of the Revised Statutes and to amend section eighty-seven of chapter six of the Revised Statutes relating to the duties of the Treasurer of State.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section I. Section sixty-seven of chapter two of the Re-2 vised Statutes is hereby repealed.
 - Sect. 2. Section eighty-seven of chapter six of the Revised
- 2 Statutes is hereby amended so as to read as follows:
 - 'Sect. 87. When a State tax is imposed and required to
- 4 be assessed by the proper officers of towns, the treasurer of
- 5 State shall send such warrants, as he is, from time to time,

6 ordered to issue for the assessment thereof, to the assessors 7 requiring them forthwith to assess the sum apportioned to 8 their town or place, and to commit their assessment to the 9 constable or collector for collection.'

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
