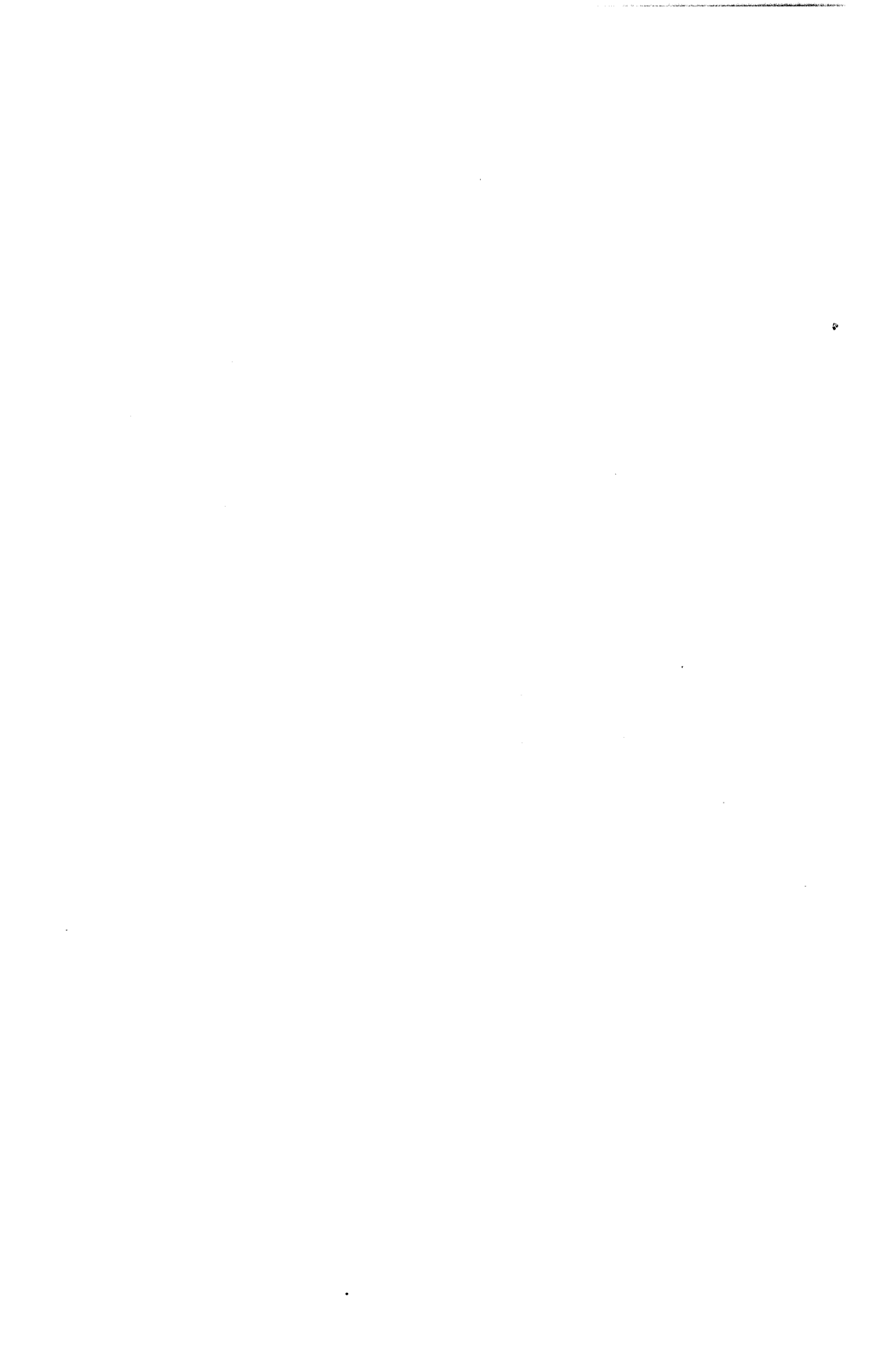
AN ACT to amend section twelve of chapter three of the Revised Statutes as amended by chapter three hundred and thirty-five of the Public Laws of 1885 and to repeal conflicting statutes relating to the election of collectors of taxes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section twelve of chapter three of the Revised
2 Statutes as amended by chapter three hundred and thirty-five
3 of the Public Laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-five is
4 hereby amended by adding thereto the following words:
5 'nor shall a collector be eligible to or hold the office of treas-
6 urer until he has completed his duties under his warrant and
7 had a final settlement with the town.'

Sect. 2. Section one hundred and seventy-six of chapter
2 six of the Revised Statutes and all other acts and parts of
3 acts inconsistent with the preceding section are hereby
4 repealed.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
