STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE making an Appropriation for the Ownership and
Maintenance of State and County Bridges.

Resolved, That for the purpose of carrying into effect
2 the provisions of an act entitled "An Act to provide for
3 the ownership and maintenance of highway bridges by the
4 state and the several counties," the following sums be,
5 and the same are hereby, appropriated for the year nine-
6 teen hundred and three: for the purchase of existing
7 highway bridges, forty-four thousand dollars (\$44,000);
8 for maintenance, thirty-four thousand dollars (\$34,000);
9 for construction of new bridges, ten thousand dollars
10 (\$10,000); for the purchase of private and toll bridges,
11 two thousand dollars (\$2,000); the following sums are

12 hereby appropriated for the year nineteen hundred and
13 four: for the purchase of existing highway bridges, forty-
14 four thousand dollars (\$44,000); for maintenance,
15 thirty-three thousand dollars (\$33,000); for construction
16 of new bridges, seventeen thousand dollars (\$17,000);
17 for the purchase of private and toll bridges, two thousand
18 dollars (\$2,000).

The Committee on Ways and Bridges, to which was referred the bill entitled "An Act to maintain large bridges by the county and state," have had the same under consideration and ask leave to report the accompanying resolve, entitled "Resolve making an appropriation for the ownership and maintenance of state and county bridges."
