STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT to grant certain powers to the Hancock County
Trustees of Public Reservations.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The incorporation of the Hancock County
2 Trustees of Public Reservations, a corporation organized at
3 Bar Harbor, Maine, under the Revised Statutes of Maine,
4 chapter 55, is hereby ratified and confirmed.

Sect. 2. Said corporation shall have power to acquire,
2 by devise, gift or purchase, and to own, arrange, hold,
3 maintain and improve, for free public use, lands in Han-
4 cock county, Maine, which by reason of scenic beauty,

5 historical interest, sanitary advantages, or for other
6 reasons, may be available for the purpose.

Sect. 3. Lands and improvements thereon, held by
2 said corporation, for free public use, shall be exempt from
3 state, county, or town taxation.

Sect. 4. This act shall take effect when approved.
