STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT to provide blanks, books and stationery for the Dover

Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. It shall be the duty of the county commissioners

- 2 of the county of Piscataquis to furnish and provide at the
- 3 expense of the county, all books, blanks, and all necessary
- 4 stationery and supplies required for the use of the Dover
- 5 municipal court in the town of Dover, in the transaction of
- 6 the civil and criminal business of said court, including proper
- 7 books for the record of all cases arising in said court, at a
- 8 cost not exceeding one hundred dollars per year.

- Sect. 2. All acts or parts of acts, conflicting with this act, 2 are hereby repealed.
- Sect. 3. This act shall go into effect on the first day of 2 April in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and 3 three.
