STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE to provide means for examinations of claims for
State Pensions.

Resolved, That the State pension clerk is hereby authorized
2 to expend such sum, under the direction of the governor and
3 council, not exceeding three hundred dollars yearly, as may
4 be necessary to properly examine the claims presented to his
5 office, the same to be paid out of the appropriation for State
6 pensions for the years nineteen hundred and three and nine-
7 teen hundred and four, upon proper vouchers filed with the
8 governor and council fully itemized as to dates, amounts and
9 subject matter thereof.
