STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT to authorize municipalities to make contracts for water, gas and light.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. Municipal corporations are authorized to con-
- 2 tract for a supply of water, gas and electric light for munici-
- 3 pal uses for a term of years upon such terms as may be
- 4 mutually agreed, from time to time to renew the same, and
- 5 to raise money therefor.
 - Sect. 2. This act may take effect when approved.
