STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT to amend section one of chapter 242 of the Public
Laws of 1889.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section one of chapter 242 of the Public Laws of 1889 is
2 hereby amended by striking out the words "eighteen hundred
3 and eighty-nine" in the first and second lines of said section
4 and inserting instead thereof the words 'nineteen hundred and
5 three,' and by striking out the word "fifteen" in the third line
6 of said section and inserting in its place the word 'eighteen'
7 so that said section as amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 1. From and after January first, nineteen hundred
9 and three, the salary of the adjutant-general shall be eighteen
10 hundred dollars per annum, payable quarterly, instead of the
11 sum now provided by law.'
