STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT to grant testimonials of honorable service to soldiers
who served in the War with Spain.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The governor is hereby authorized to issue testimonials of appropriate design to all soldiers who served in the war with Spain, and have been honorably discharged, and to widows or next in kin of such as have deceased.

Sect. 2. The sum of one thousand five hundred dollars, or as much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated for the purpose of carrying out the provisions of this act.

Sect. 3. This act to take effect when approved.
