STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT to amend section one of chapter 249 of the Public
Laws of 1901.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section one of chapter 249 of the Public Laws of 1901 is
2 hereby amended by striking out the word "one" in the second
3 line of said section and inserting in its place the word 'three,'
4 and by striking out the word "eighteen" in the third line of
5 said section and inserting in its place the word 'nineteen,' so
6 that said section as amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 1. From and after January first nineteen hundred
8 and three the amount allowed for clerk hire in the office of the
9 adjutant-general shall be nineteen hundred dollars per
10 annum, payable quarterly, instead of the sum now provided
11 by law.'
