STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT to amend chapter 94 of the Public Laws of 1887, relating to agricultural societies.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section I. Chapter 94 of the Public Laws of 1887 is hereby 2 amended by inserting after the word "county" in the second 3 line the words 'and local', so said chapter as amended will 4 read as follows:

'Chapter 94. Sec. 1. The receipts of the Maine State Agri-6 cultural Society, the Eastern Maine State Fair and all county 7 and local agricultural societies, are hereby exempted from 8 attachment, trustee process and seizure on execution until 9 current expenses of the fair, purses and premiums awarded 10 by the society are paid, provided that the same are paid 11 within three months from the close of the fair.'

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
