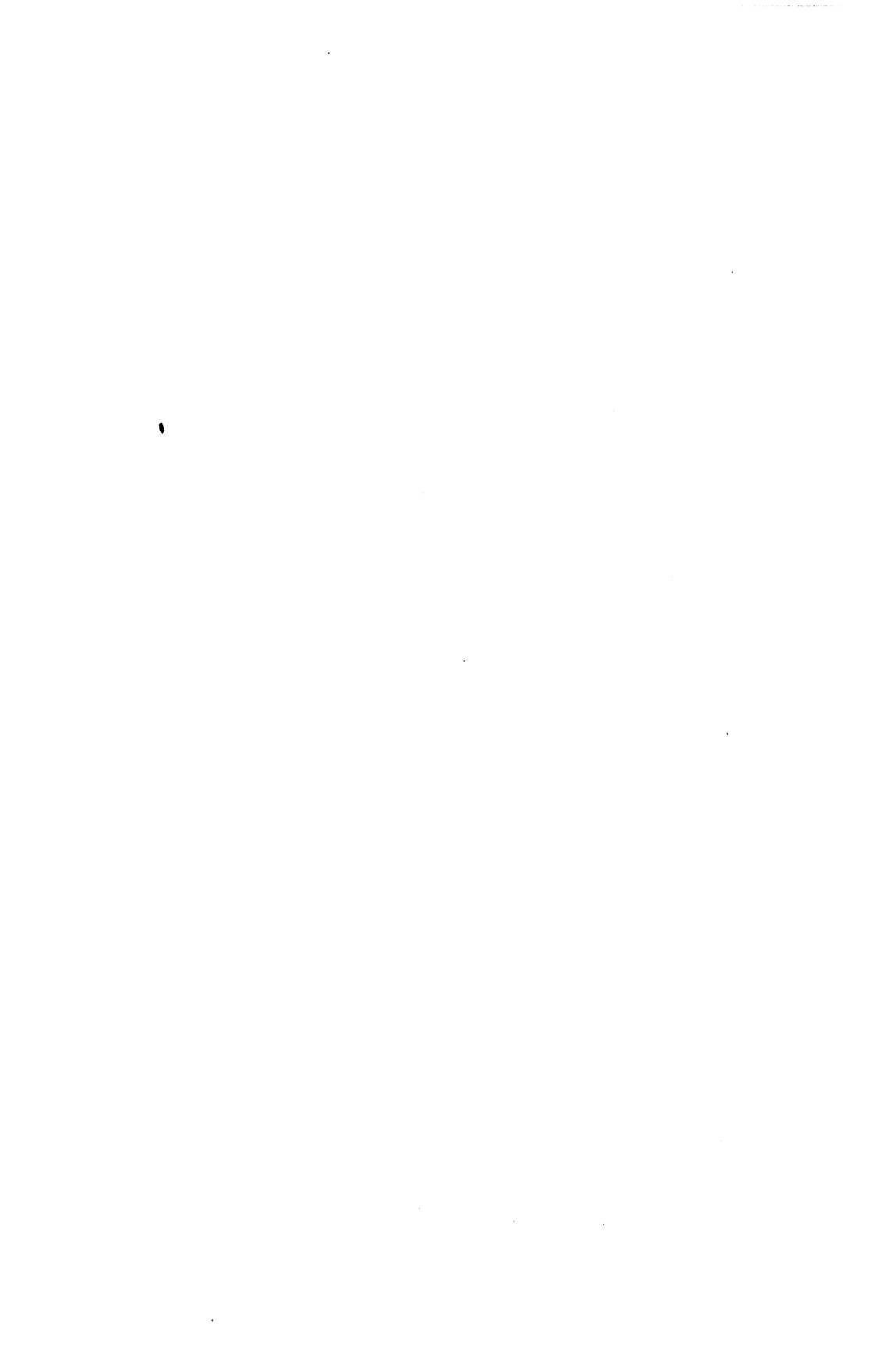
AN ACT relating to the authority of courts over guardians ad
litem or next friend.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. No settlement of any suit brought in behalf of
2 an infant by next friend shall be valid unless approved by
3 the court in which the action is pending, or to which the writ
4 is returnable, or affirmed by an entry of judgment. The
5 court may make all necessary orders for protecting the inter-
6 ests of the infant, and may require the guardian ad litem,
7 or next friend, to give bond to truly account for all money
8 received in behalf of the infant.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
