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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND THREE.

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AN ACT to amend section four of chapter eighty-six of the Revised Statutes as amended by chapter one hundred fifty-seven, Public Laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-three, relating to trustee suits.

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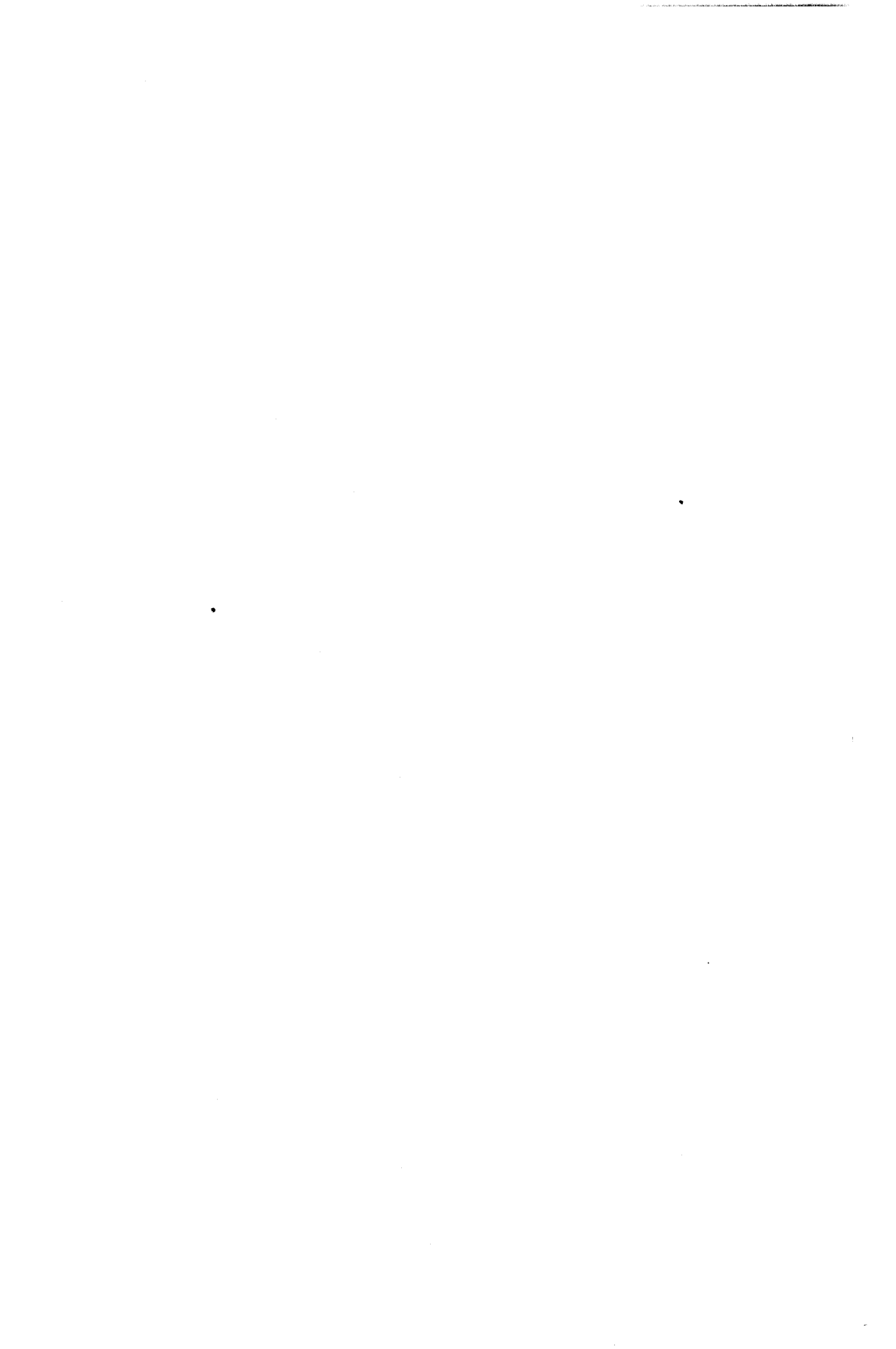
*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Section four of chapter eighty-six of the Revised  
2 Statutes as amended by chapter one hundred fifty-seven of  
3 the Public Laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-three is  
4 hereby amended by inserting after the word "firm" in the  
5 fifth line of said section the words 'at the place of business  
6 of the firm,' and by striking out from the last clause of said  
7 section the words "provided legal service shall be afterwards

8 made upon the other members of the firm," so that said sec-  
9 tion as amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 4. A like service on the trustee binds all goods,  
11 effects, or credits of the principal defendant entrusted to and  
12 deposited in his possession, to respond to the final judgment  
13 in the action, as when attached by ordinary process. When  
14 a partnership is made a trustee in a trustee suit, service upon  
15 one member of the firm at the place of business of the firm,  
16 shall be a sufficient attachment of the property of the prin-  
17 cipal defendant in the possession of the firm.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
