STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT to amend section twenty-one of chapter one hundred and sixteen of the Revised Statutes, and chapters two hundred and twenty-five of the Public Laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-three, relating to fees of Registers of Deeds.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section twenty-one of chapter one hundred and sixteen of the Revised Statutes, is hereby amended by adding thereto the following:

4 Recording certificates of limited partnership, fifty cents.
5 Receiving and filing certificate of election of clerk of a corporation, or resignation of such clerk, twenty-five cents.

- 7 Recording certificates of organization of corporations and
8 making copy thereof, two dollars.
9 Recording certificates of foreclosure of mortgages, or notices
10 of foreclosure, fifty cents.'

Sect. 2. Chapter two hundred and twenty-five of the Public
2 Laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-three, is hereby
3 amended by striking out the words "under seal" in the third
4 line. So that said chapter as amended shall read as follows:

'Chapter 225. In all cases where books with printed forms
6 are not furnished therefor, registers of deeds shall for receiv-
7 ing, filing and recording any instrument by law entitled to
8 record, in addition to the fees now fixed by law, the sum of
9 fifteen cents for each hundred words or fraction thereof, in
10 excess of five hundred words.'
