To the Honorable President of the Senate:

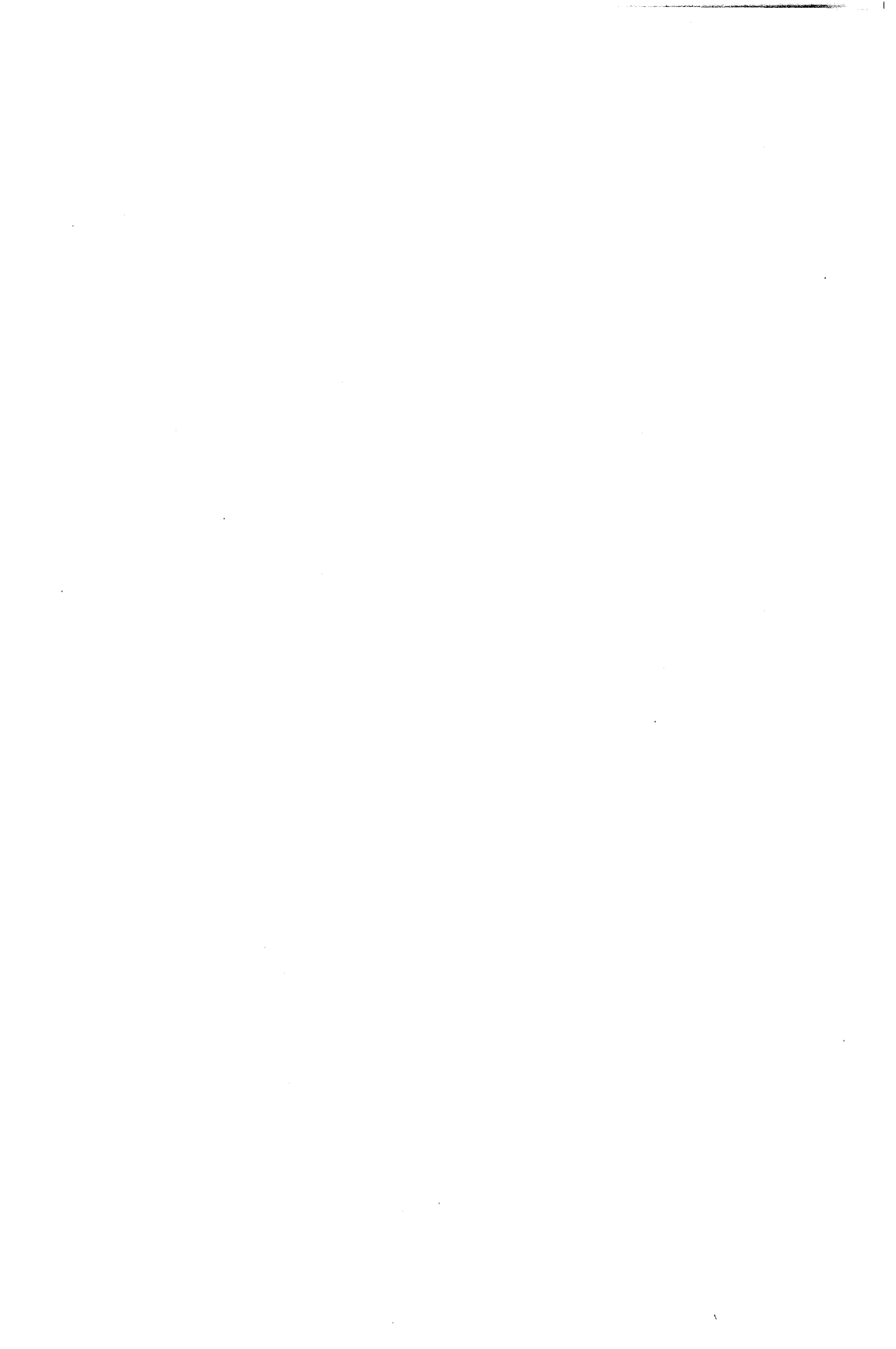
