STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT to amend section two of chapter twenty of the
Revised Statutes, relating to Ferries.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Section two of chapter twenty of the Revised
2 Statutes is hereby amended by inserting after the word
3 "tolls" in the second line of said section the words "and
4 shall discontinue such ferries when, in their judgment, it
5 may be expedient," so that said section, as amended, shall
6 read as follows:

'Sect. 2. They may establish ferries at such times and
8 places as are necessary, and fix their tolls, and shall dis-
9 continue such ferries when, in their judgment, it may be

10 expedient. When no person is found to keep them there-
11 for, the towns in which they are established shall provide
12 a person to be licensed to keep them, and shall pay the
13 expenses, beyond the amount of tolls received, for main-
14 taining them. When established between towns, they
15 shall be maintained by them in such proportions as
16 the commissioners order. For each month's neglect to
17 maintain such ferry or its proportion thereof, a town for-
18 feits forty dollars.'

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
